

PASSION INTO MISSION CONSIDERATIONS

1. This is an on-ramp to something more lasting and personal.
2. Invite a mix of believers and unbelievers to participate.
3. This can also encourage and equip believers in their own journeys.
4. You can train other believers to do the same thing you are doing.
5. Be intentional about involving believers. (TIP: Give them this training.)
6. We will not reach the world by addition, but by multiplication.
7. It is important to pray or ask someone else to pray.
8. Check for any conflicts with your location (timing, rules, etc.).
9. Be open to letting others contact you with questions.
10. You can share your own devotion instead of someone else's.
11. Consider making this a regular event for ongoing opportunities.
12. Always share a clear presentation of the gospel (in word or print).

PART THREE: Your Passion = Your Mission

1. Resist the tendency to think that only pastors, missionaries or other “qualified” people can make disciples.
2. Any follower of Jesus can do this, and every follower of Jesus has been called to do this.

*Gather with people who share your passion
so you can share Jesus.*
